SPONSORED LEGISLATION


- Submission of public question by referendum to Chicago voters at next regular election proposing increase of City of Chicago real estate transfer tax for purposes of providing resources for affordable housing and services to combat homelessness
- Amendment of 2023 Annual Appropriation Ordinance by reappropriating salaries from police vacancies to fund Department of Public Health's mental health crisis response teams to address crises and offload stress on 911 system
- Amendment of Municipal Code Titles 2 and 17 to further regulate affordable conversion units, additional dwelling unit-limitation areas and coach houses
- Calling on Chicago Department of Public Health to seek grants and funding to establish non-police mental health crisis response program
- Amendment of Municipal Code Titles 2 and 3 by modifying various sections and adding new Sections 2-36-761 and 2-84-451 regarding death benefits to surviving spouses of first responders who die by suicide
- Amendment of Municipal Code Sections 1-23-010 and 1-23-020 regarding ineligibility to do business with City of Chicago due to removal from public office, treason, sedition or related offenses
